2020 CHARDONNAY WILLAMETTE VALLEY



La Maisonnette Chardonnay is a new cuvée produced from two Drouhin Family vineyards in the Willamette Valley. Whereas Chardonnay Arthur is a beautiful expression of the Dundee Hills and the Roserock Chardonnay captures the Eola-Amity Hills spirit, La Maisonnette creates something entirely different. It is a lively, immediately approachable wine that typifies why there is so much excitement around Dijon-clone Oregon Chardonnay today. In a word: delicious.

Grape Variety: 100% Chardonnay

AVA: Willamette Valley, Oregon

ABV: 13.9%

The 2020 Vintage: The inside 2020 story is that the Chardonnay growing season was nearly ideal. The first three months of the year were relatively dry. Budbreak took place in mid-April; light rain during flowering led to lovely small berries and clusters, and wide temperature swings resulted in a beautiful crop heading into harvest. Unfortunately, smoke from wildfires made it impossible to produce the caliber of Pinot Noir you expect from us, but the Chardonnay was impeccable. Thank goodness for silver linings!
