The Pegaso Pizarra vineyards lie on metamorphic rock with a laminar structure. This type of slate soil is very rare in the DO Cebreros. They are almost only found in the vicinity of the Arrebatacapas pass between 850 and 1,200m asl, where we own a number of vineyards.

These slate soils provide a broader, more approachable texture and fine-grained tannins.

ELABORATION AND AGING
Native yeasts. 24-30 months in barrels of 500 and 400 liters of French oak from different forests and origins.

SOILS
Slate soils on metamorphic rock with a laminar structure. Mainly oriented to the east, at altitudes above 950 meters.

VINTAGE CHARACTERISTICS
The year started with a moderate early bud break, which was affected by the cold periods in March. A cold and rainy spring delayed flowering 10 to 12 days. A hot, dry summer brought the harvest forward to normal dates and significantly reduced the expected harvest. The grapes arrived healthy at the end of the cycle, with good polyphenolic ripeness, moderate alcohol and medium acidity. It was a year of good aromatic quality and soft tannins.

The slate soils provide a broader and gentler texture with fine-grained tannin, over a complex and original aromatic expression, marked by notes of rockrose, rosemary and lavender, wrapped in balsamic and mineral sensations. A deep, intense and harmonious wine.
